



Camp Discount Eligibility:

- Child must be age 6-14 (can be age 5, but must be entering kindergarten), **AND** a
- Duval county resident **AND**
- Provide **ONE** of the below proof documents.
 1. Have an Individualized Education Plan (IEP) **OR** is a recipient of the Family Empowerment Scholarship for Students with Unique Abilities (FES-UA)
 2. Under Protective Services or in foster care – regardless of income
 3. Provide copies of pay stubs for two pay periods as proof the student live in a family whose income is (100%) or below the state median income level (SMI) for Duval County based on family. SNAP, Medicaid etc. qualifies **See chart below OR**

4. Qualifies for Free or Reduced lunch. CEP schools provide school breakfast and lunch to all students at no charge regardless of income. Therefore, students enrolled in a CEP school **CANNOT** use their free or reduced lunch status for eligibility. If the parent submitted a free or reduced lunch application and was awarded such, the award letter is an acceptable proof document for eligibility and can be obtained by contacting DCPS Free Lunch Approval 904-732-5145. Otherwise, eligibility must be met utilizing one of the above 3 methods.
